

Minutes of the Stafford County  
Electoral Board  
June 10-13, 2018

At 8 AM on Monday June 10, 2018 the Stafford County Electoral Board held a meeting in the General Registrar's office located at 1300 Courthouse Road, Stafford, Virginia 22554. The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Doug Filler. Roll call: Chairman, Doug Filler; Vice Chairman, Marie Gozzi; Secretary, Gloria Chittum; and General Registrar, Greg Riddlemoser, were present.

Minutes of the March 18, 2018 meeting were read and approved. There was no old business.

**New Business:** Greg discussed how well the pre-election mandatory training went and also discussed that there is a new statement of results which had been gone over in training. We are prepared for a 60% turnout – way too high but better to have too many than not enough ballots. Greg also stated the loading of the cages went fairly well on Sunday. **Calendar Review:** The Canvass will be held in the Clerk's office at 10AM on Wednesday and continue Noon on Friday if necessary. Training in Richmond will be on June 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> but we'll be going down on Sunday. Greg advised office would be closed due to the fact Anna and Jincy would also be attending. **Budget Review:** Money is low but there is enough to pay bills. Officer of Election Appointments: Gloria made motion to approve the four (4) new officers of election Doug seconded and Marie voted in favor. **Redistricting Update:** Greg predicts the need for eight (8) more precincts and we'll continue working with the Board of Supervisors and county staff on the preliminaries.

Doug made a motion to recess this meeting, Marie seconded, and all voted in favor. Meeting to resume for the June Primary Election tomorrow and canvass on Wednesday in Clerk's office at 10AM. Marie made a statement about how much she appreciated Greg and much good work he is doing.

Wednesday June 12, 2018 at 10AM: Chairman Doug Filler reopened the meeting of the Stafford County Electoral Board for the purpose to canvass the June Primary held on Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup> 2018. All members were present. Since no visitors were present the meeting was not closed for the Provisional Meeting. There were a total of eleven (11) ballots; Greg gave us a reason why one ballot should not be counted but that the other ten (10) should be. We voted unanimously to count ten (10) ballots. Provisional meeting closed and the meeting for regular canvass continued. Once the Canvass was completed at 11:20am, Doug called for the meeting to adjourn, Marie seconded and all voted in favor.
