

STAFFORD COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD
OCTOBER 19, 2021
MINUTES

The Stafford County Electoral Board met at 1300 Courthouse Rd, Stafford, VA 22554 in the Economic Development Conference Room. Chairman, Jim Minor called the meeting to order at 12 Noon.

Roll Call: Present were Chairman, Jim Minor, Vice Chairman, Brandynicole Brooks, Secretary, Gloria Chittum, General Registrar, Anna Hash, two (2) visitors, Tony DeTora, Chairman Stafford County Republican Party, and Clayton Hill, a member of the Democratic Party of Stafford County.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Gloria made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 27, 2021 meeting. Brandynicole seconded, and all voted in favor.

NEW BUSINESS:

EARLY VOTING CAMPAIGNING: Jim asked Clayton to come speak about different issues that were going on outside the forty (40) foot line. Clayton explained there had been one individual in the beginning that had caused problems, and she was asked by the Democratic Party not to return. After that, he said the Republican party started harassing the Democrats, and things just seemed to get out of hand. Gloria stated she was coming every day, and things seemed to be doing better. Clayton agreed with her, but also stated at times it would start back up. Anna said she sent a statement about what could and could not be done by the Electoral Board and the Registrar which really cut down on the number of complaints she was getting every day. Tony said he only knew what his volunteers and Gloria reported to him, stating he had not any communication with Ben Litchfield, Chairman of the Democratic Party of Stafford. Tony said he would talk to his volunteers and advise them to please be more respectful. At this time, Brandynicole asked what had accomplished other than we have no control over what happens outside the forty (40) foot line. We all agreed. Jim informed Tony and Clayton they could leave or stay for the remainder of the meeting. They thanked us for letting them be there and left. Jim said he was really concerned about problems on Election Day. Anna assured him there would be deputies dedicated to patrolling the precincts on Election Day. Brandynicole said she thought we should have a statement to release to the parties regarding the Electoral Board's responsibilities beyond the forty (40) foot line and that she would draft the statement and send it out so we could make necessary changes.


