

**STAFFORD COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD
MINUTES JUNE 20, 2022**

The Stafford County Electoral Board met at the office of the General Registrar located at 1300 Courthouse Rd, Stafford, VA, 22554. Jim called the meeting to order at 12 PM.

Roll Call: Present were Jim Minor, Chairman, Brandynicole Brooks, Vice Chairman, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, Anna Hash, General Registrar, McKenzie Burton, Assistant Registrar. There were no observers present.

Approval of Minutes: Brandynicole made a motion to accept minutes from the February 28, 2022 meeting. Gloria seconded, and all voted in favor.

Unfinished Business: None

New Business: Anna reported everything is ready for the Republican Primary being held on, Tuesday, June 21, 2022. Gloria swore in the Chiefs and gave them their materials. Cages have been delivered to the precincts. Anna reported she is not expecting a big turn-out.

Closed Session: At 12:15 PM, Brandynicole made a motion to go into closed session. Gloria seconded, and all voted in favor for the purpose of discussing security matters. At 12:53, Jim moved us back into open session having only discussed security matters.

Open Session: Brandynicole made a motion to appoint election officials. Jim seconded, and all voted in favor. We then went into recess until 6 AM, Tuesday June 21, 2022, and to continue Wednesday through Friday to conduct the canvass.

Tuesday, June 21, 2022

Tuesday, June 21st 2022, the primary was held throughout the county in our 27 precincts, and the Electoral Board rotated through their assigned precincts, as has been done in the past. The Electoral Board supervised the return of election materials and posting of results at the end of the night. There were 9900 ballots cast, which was a turnout of 9.06%

Wednesday, June 22, 2022

Jim Minor, Chairman, opened the meeting at 12:15 PM .

ROLL CALL: Present were Jim Minor, Chairman, Brandynicole Brooks, Vice Chairman, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, Anna Hash, General Registrar, McKenzie Burton, Assistant Registrar.


There were no observers present. We conducted the canvass which was completed at 12:40PM. At 12:44 PM, Brandynicole moved us into closed session to discuss a personnel matter. Jim seconded, and all voted in favor. At 12:50 PM we went back into open session having only discussed personnel matters. At 12:51 PM, Brandynicole moved us into recess until Friday. Jim seconded, and all voted in favor.

Friday, June 24, 2022

Jim Minor, Chairman, opened the meeting at 12:05 PM

ROLL CALL: Present were Jim Minor, Chairman, Brandynicole Brooks, Vice Chairman, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, Anna Hash, General Registrar, Mckenzie Burton, Assistant Registrar. There were no observers present. Anna reported there were 12 provisional ballots to consider. The Electoral Board determined 11 ballots were eligible to be counted. At 12:15 PM, Brandynicole made a motion to go into closed session to count these ballots. Jim seconded, and all voted in favor. At 12:24 PM, Jim moved us back into open session. At this time, we discussed the need for more election officials, as we will have 10 additional precincts in November. Anna said she would like to have them by October 1st but would still take them after that time if need be. Election officials are paid \$125, Assistant Chiefs receive \$155 and Chiefs are paid \$185. They are all paid \$15 for attending mandatory training. There being no further business, at 12:53 PM Jim made a motion to adjourn. Brandynicole seconded, and all voted in favor.
