

**STAFFORD COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD  
MINUTES JUNE 19, 2023**

The Stafford County Electoral Board met at 1300 Courthouse Road Stafford, VA 22554 on Monday, June 19, 2023 in the office of the General Registrar at 1PM. Brandynicole Brooks, Chair, called the meeting to order.

**Roll Call:** Present were Brandynicole Brooks, Chair, Adela Bertoldi, Vice Chair, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, and Anna Hash, General Registrar. There were no visitors.

**New Business:** Election preparations

Gloria had sworn in all of the chiefs and had given them their supplies. Anna stated all equipment had been delivered and everything was ready for the election tomorrow.

Anna requested envelope 1A be opened Tuesday night to compare names on provisional log to the provisional ballot envelopes. Brandynicole made a motion that members of the Electoral Board will open the envelopes and turn them over to Anna for this purpose. Gloria seconded, and all voted in favor.

Anna said she would like to start using Print Elect for the initial mailing of absentee ballots. Gloria made a motion to have Print Elect mail the first ballot mailing. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor. Anna asked us to meet in the office tomorrow, June 20, between noon and 12:30 PM to meet two interns. They will be going to different precincts and will also be IT rovers. There being no further business Brandynicole made a motion to recess until tomorrow, June 20, 2023 for the election. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor.

**Tuesday June 20,2023**

Today is election day, and we board members have been visiting our assigned precincts. We came back to the office for lunch between noon and 12:30 PM and met and visited with the two interns who were excited to be able to take a part in this election. They had been to a couple of the precincts and were going to visit a few more. We enjoyed meeting them and talking with them. After lunch, we returned to visiting our precincts.

**Wednesday June 21,2023**

At 12:03 PM, Brandynicole reconvened the meeting.

**Roll Call:** Present were Brandynicole Brooks, Chair, Adela Bertoldi, Vice Chair, Gloria Chittum Secretary, Anna Hash General Registrar, and McKenzie Taylor, Chief Deputy Registrar. There were no visitors. At this time, we did the canvas for yesterday's election. There being no further business Brandynicole made a motion at 1:04 PM to go into recess until 12:00 PM Friday, June 23, 2023. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor.

**Friday June 23, 2023**

At 12:19 PM, Brandynicole reconvened the meeting.


**Roll Call:** Present were Brandynicole Brooks, Chair, Adela Bertoldi, Vice Chair, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, Anna Hash, General Registrar, McKenzie Taylor, Chief Deputy Registrar. Gregg Snyder was also present. Post Election mail was canvassed. Then we read and discussed incident reports. We also discussed training in November and the need to focus on paper work completed by chiefs at the end of election night. We spoke about community education on where people go vote on Election Day. Brandynicole took us into closed session at 1:08 PM to discuss personnel matters. At 1:45, PM we moved out of closed session into open session. There being no further business, Brandynicole moved us into recess until 12 noon on Monday, June 26, 2023. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor.

### **Monday, June 26, 2023**

Brandynicole reconvened the Electoral Board meeting at 12:00PM on Monday, June 26, 2023.

**Roll Call:** Present were Brandynicole Brooks, Chair, Adela Bertoldi, Vice Chair, Gloria Chittum, Secretary, Anna Hash, General Registrar, McKenzie Taylor, Chief Deputy Registrar, as well as Gregg Snyder and Daniel Gualdual who was from Nikki Baldwin's campaign. We reviewed and declared which Provisional votes could be counted and which ones could not. There were 76 provisional ballots to be counted. At 12:26 PM Brandynicole moved us into closed session. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor. When all ballots had been counted there were 38 Democrat and 38 Republican ballots cast. Durant 16, Strickland 21 with one under vote, Peters 17, Kasey 6, Litchfield 12, Griffin 21. Brandynicole moved us out of closed session at 12:56 PM. We announced the results from the Provisional Ballots cast. Brandynicole moved us back into closed session at 1:15 PM to do the registrar's evaluation. Adela seconded, and all voted in favor. At 1:45 PM Brandynicole moved us back into open session and adjourned the meeting. Gloria seconded, and all voted in favor.
