

Stafford County Electoral Board
Minutes
March 18, 2018

The Stafford County Electoral Board met on March 18th, 2018 in the General Registrar's Office, at 1300 Courthouse Road, Stafford, Va. 22554. Chairman Doug Filler called meeting to order at 9AM. Roll call was done and all members were present: Doug Filler, Chairman; Marie Gozzi, Vice Chairman; Gloria Chittum, Secretary; and guest Greg Riddlemoser, General Registrar. Minutes for November 6th thru November 14th 2017 were read and approved as presented.

Old Business: (1) All lawsuits for the 2017 November General election have been withdrawn. (2) Street files have been corrected. There have been no phone calls received regarding this or the letters and post cards mailed to inform the affected voters (about a third of which were returned undeliverable).

New Business: (1) Redistricting - it's up to the Board of Supervisors to do the redistricting, not us. Greg stated he would like to have some input because we are certainly affected by their decisions. We'll need to budget about \$150,000 to mail new voter cards to every voter. (2) Selection of Electoral Board Officers. Marie made motion to leave officers the same, (Doug Filler, Chairman; Marie Gozzi, Vice Chairman; Gloria Chittum, Secretary) seconded by Doug, all voted yes. (3) Our internal Security Plan was discussed Marie made motion to re-adopt, Gloria seconded, all voted in favor. (4) Greg advised us that the 2017 recounts cost \$28,000.00. (5) Doug made motion to approve new officers of election as presented; Gloria seconded, all voted in favor. (6) Gloria made motion that Greg be allowed to undertake other duties that do not conflict with his duties in this office as allowed in **§ 24.2-110**; Marie seconded, all voted in favor. (7) Greg discussed new form for statement-of-results and asked for permission to use the new form. Doug made motion, Gloria seconded, all voted in favor. (8) Greg also gave us the updates on the June Primary. We will be doing L&A on Monday April 23rd, 2018 at 8:30 am starting in the registrar's office. 60% ballots to be ordered. We will be ready.

There being no further business Doug made motion to adjourn, Marie seconded and then offered Greg a special thanks for all his work in keeping us informed on the General Assembly over the past couple months, all voted in favor of

adjournment. Our next meeting will be Monday, June 11th at 8a.m., when we'll discuss election preparations.
