FRIDAY MAY 8, 2020
MINUTES

The Stafford County Electoral Board met at the General Registrar's Office located at 1300 Courthouse Road Stafford, VA 22554. At 9:10 AM Chairman, Marie Gozzi, called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Present were Chairman, Marie Gozzi. Vice Chairman, Jim Minor, Secretary, Gloria Chittum, General Registrar, Anna Hash.

The minutes of the March 2, 2020 and March 17, 2020 Electoral Board meetings were read. Marie made a motion to accept the minutes and Jim seconded. All voted in favor.

OLD BUSINESS: The BOS on April 21st 2020 voted no to our new office. The BOS decided we would have a Satellite Precinct to be located at the Stafford Airport.

NEW BUSINESS: We discussed plans and preparations for the November Presidential Election. Anna advised we will have a team at the Airport and another team here at the County Building. She will be setting up a meeting with Mike Smith, Deputy Administrator, very soon to make sure we have the ABC Room and discuss parking and curb side voting. Anna advised us she had ordered 30% or (32,000) Ballots for the upcoming Primary, We do have enough workers for each precinct at this time. We have all the necessary protective equipment such as mask, gloves, hand sanitizer. Thomas has been making protective shields for each precinct. Training will be done by video. On pick-up day only one chief at a time will be allowed in to get material. On election night when materials are returned, the chief's will come in one at a time. It will take a little longer, but we are interested in the safety of everyone involved. We discussed early-processing of mail-in ballots for the June Primary. Gloria made a motion to do this, and Marie seconded. All voted in favor. We also reviewed and talked about and signed the voting equipment security plan. Our next Board meeting will be Monday, June 22nd 2020 at 2 PM. There being no further business, Gloria made a motion to adjourn at 10:35 AM. Marie seconded, and all voted in favor.
