Committee Reports

Unfinished Business

 <u>Pet Insurance</u> – Department of Human Resources declined to pursue pet insurance as an option for employees.

New Business

- <u>EAC Reviewed Policies</u> The Leadership Team has requested a list of policies the
 EAC has reviewed in the past. While recalling EAC reviewed policies, members
 concluded that all policies relating to employees should be reviewed and updated.
 During this discussion it was agreed that a policy review should be performed by a third
 party.
- <u>Concealed Carry Policy Review</u> An EAC representative proposed a review of the current concealed carry policy. The representative suggested a county employee should have the option to carry a concealed firearm for protection when working offsite.
- Newsletter Donna Krauss requested the EAC to consider a proposed idea of producing a newsletter. The (EAC) newsletter would replace the current newsletter ("The Watercooler"). After a brief discussion, members agreed that producing a newsletter was

- not within the scope of the EAC's guidelines, and would be time consuming and labor intensive to EAC volunteers.
- <u>Birthday Suggestions</u> The EAC was requested to brainstorm ideas regarding employee birthdays. Members concluded birthday recognition should be organized at the departmental level.
- <u>EAC Operational Guidelines</u> Members reviewed the EAC Operational Guidelines and were previously informed that the EAC was restricted from making any amendments.
 Members agreed the EAC should have the opportunity to review the Operational Guidelines and request changes if deemed necessary.
- <u>EAC Meeting Attendance</u> The topic of EAC meeting attendance was presented and discussed. The discussion concluded that if an EAC representative is having difficulties attending the monthly meetings then the EAC chair is to contact the member's department director.
- <u>Communication with Leadership Team</u> A motion was introduced proposing direct communication with the EAC and the Leadership Team. The motion was 2nd and passed with a unanimous vote.
