

Public Notice to all Stafford Citizens

In 2011, we will redraw (redistrict) the existing seven Stafford County election district boundaries that we use to elect our local government officials (which include: Stafford County Board of Supervisors and the Stafford County School Board) in response to results of the 2010 U.S. Census. Adjustments to voting precincts and locations may also be made at this time. New Stafford County election districts are to be adopted in July 2011.

The 2011 redistricting process will be an open public process that will include numerous opportunities for Stafford County citizens to learn more, provide input and participate and includes the following public process and meetings:
