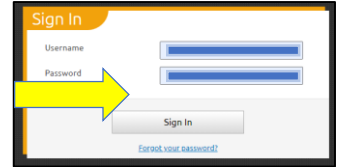


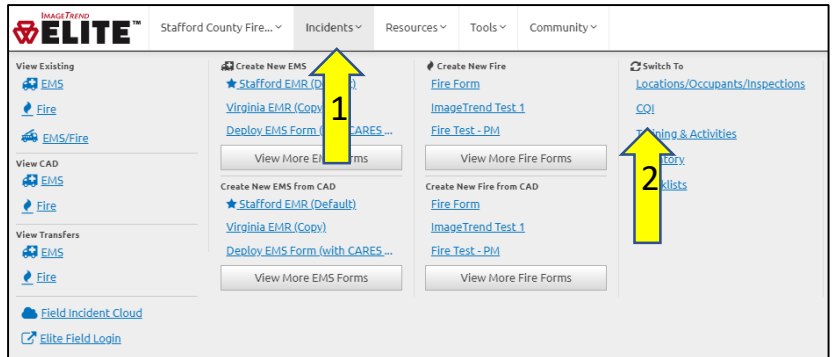


ePCR Review Flowchart for EMS Supervisor

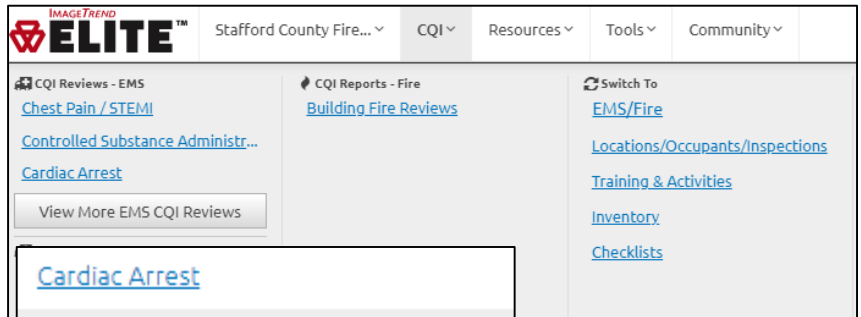

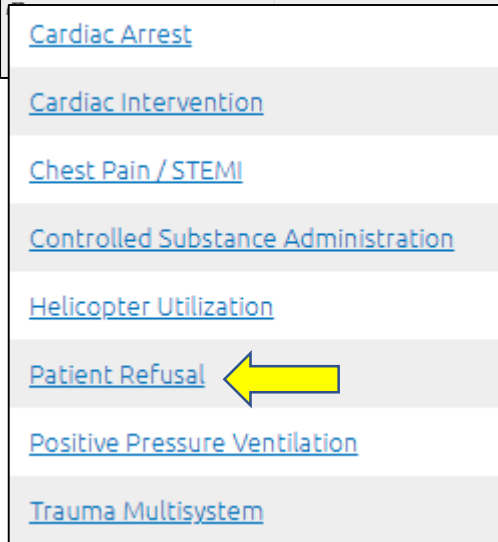
Click on **Incidents** (1) and then on **CQI** (2)



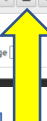

After typing your message select **Send** at the bottom of the page

The EMS Supervisor completes a ePCR CQI Review for the last shift day worked (0700-0700) for:

- Patient Refusals (AMA)
- Cardiac Arrests
- Chest Pain/Stemi
- Use of Air Medical Transport
- Use of advanced airway procedure/CPAP
- Specific CQI Performance Indicators as identified by the QM Coordinator.

The chart review should include:

- Completing the CQI Review questions specific to each call type
- Patient's demographic information, to include Medical Record Number.
- At least two complete sets of vital signs.
- Physio Control Data (EKG/Vital Signs) is downloaded to ePCR
- Pertinent Activities, Procedures, and Medications are documented
- Medication uses and medical care are within compliant to SCFRD protocols.
- Accurate and appropriate narrative.
- Correct signatures obtained for patient, witnesses, hospital staff, and clinicians.
